<p>Reporting Officer received information from an unidentified party as she refused to give her identity. She had been in the Price, Utah area in a cafe and had overheard two boys talking that Debra was supposed to be in the California area with a boy from Price by the name of Dean (last name unknown).</p> <p>She stated that his dad is supposed to own the Price Bakery (last name unknown), drives a panel truck for the bakery. She thought that the boys were serious in what they were saying, however, she again refused to identify herself.</p> <p>This Officer contacted Price, Utah Police Department and inquired as to the possible identity of this individual. This Officer spoke to an Officer Ron Simpson of the Price Police Department who indicated that the boy's name was Dean Curtis, Age 20, slender build, approximately 120-125 pounds, 5'7 to 5'8, dark brown hair, medium length and drives a 1965 purple Mustang Fastback. He stated the car has wide tires on the rear with fancy chrome rims. He also has access to a white Chevrolet Van with partial lettering of the Price Bakery on the side and thought to be possibly in the Salt Lake area.</p> <p>Officer Simpson indicated that Mr. Curtis presently has a felony warrant out on him with a cash bond of \$500.00 or a property bond of \$1,000.00. This warrant is for the taking and harboring of runaways and also entering a girl's room with indecent and immoral purposes.</p> <p>Officer Simpson advised that if this subject is located to approach with extreme caution as it is believed that he is armed and dangerous. Officer Simpson also stated that Mr. Curtis is somewhat mentally retarded and is probably more dangerous due to this fact. It was unknown to Officer Simpson as to whether Mr. Curtis was in the California area, however, he did indicate that they feel he is in the Salt Lake area and possibly in the area of Liberty Park.</p> <p>Officer Simpson also stated that this information had been passed on to the Salt Lake City Police Department by his Agency.</p> <p>This was all the information this Officer could obtain at this time.</p>
