<p>COMPLAINANT: DEAN KENT</p> <p>SUBJECT: DEBRA KENT</p> <p>Reporting Officer received information that there had been an individual at Roy High School, last name White, which looked somewhat like the composite. This Officer was advised he had been involved in some indecent exposures and possibly some child molests in that area with young girls, and had been picked up by the Roy Police Department.</p> <p>Reporting Officer contacted Lt. Hammond, Roy Police inquiring information on this subject. Lt. Hammond stated he did not know of anyone by the name of White, however, he would check into this.</p> <p>Lt. Hammond contacted this Officer a few minutes later stating that there had been an individual by the name of Robert Millard Heald, [REDACTED] who had been questioned in 1972 in regards to some indecent exposures. He stated that there had been no formal charges brought against him as they were unable to come up with enough evidence to obtain a complaint, however, this individual had become very upset at the time they questioned him and he served as a student teacher and had left the High School approximately March of 1972.</p> <p>At this time Lt. Hammond was not certain of his whereabouts.</p> <p>Reporting Officer then contacted U.B.I. and was informed that there was no record at U.B.I. on this individual. Reporting Officer also requested that a TWX be sent to California Bureau of Identification requesting any information that they may have on this individual as it was the understanding of this Officer that Mr. Heald was originally from the California area.</p> <p>Reporting Officer also ran a 1027 on this individual and came up with a Utah Drivers License No. [REDACTED]. A photograph will be ordered on Mr. Heald the first thing Monday morning, 12/16/74.</p> <p>It might be noted also that Lt. Hammond indicated that this individual was a very good likeness of the composite. Reporting Officer observed a picture in a 1972 Yearbook where the hair was considerably shorter than that of the composite, however, the general facial features did somewhat match those of the composite.</p>
