ATTEMPT TO LOCATE
DEBRA KENT

Reporting officer received information that a Jarrell Hodson Seminary Teacher at S.I.S. phone number [REDACTED] home phone number [REDACTED] had been informed by an individual that Debra was possibly a runaway and gave three locations as to where she might possibly be. These were as follows:

Reporting officer then contacted Mr. Hodson who stated that he had had an individual who is presently an inmate of SIS, enter his office. At that time, he had four pictures of missing girls sitting on his desk. She immediately, upon noticing the picture of Debra stated "Oh Debra finally ran away". When questioned about this, she stated that Debra had talked to her sometime prior to her disappearance and requested information as to various places she might be able to stay if she was to runaway and go to California.

Reporting officer inquired as to whether Debra had bought or been involved in drugs, and he stated that the indication of this girl was that she had been, quite heavily.

Reporting officer then talked with Mr. Hodson a few minutes longer, indicating that at this time the indications regarding school and so forth, indicated Debra did not runaway and that her school grades did not really indicate that she was using drugs.

Mr. Hodson then revealed the source, that being Sherri Pease, stating that he did not know her very well, she had only been in SIS approximately since December 10, 1974. He could not give much information on her, although he stated that she requested that she remain anonymous. She definitely did not want Debbie to know that she was the one that gave the information to help track her down. Mr. Hodson was assured that Debbie would not have this information revealed. However, this officer indicated that there was a good possibility that reporting officer would have to make contact with Sherri and talk with her regarding this.

Reporting officer then contacted Mr. Don Murphy Inspector, San Francisco Police Dept., and gave him these two addresses requesting that he check them out to find out if Debbie had been there. A description of Debra was also supplied to Inspector Murphy. Inspector Murphy also requested a teletype be sent giving this information as a back up to this conversation. This was done immediately.
