This is an interview with a confidential informant on December 27, 1974 at 11:15 A.M. Present at the interview was the informant, Detective Beal and Sgt. Ballantyne.

Informant was informed as to the reason this officer was present. She agreed to talk with reporting officer in regard to the information regarding Debra KENT as long as this information would be held confidential, that she would not have to testify in court and her name would not be given out to anyone.

Reporting officer inquired of her as to when she met Debra. She said that she had known her for approximately four to six months. That she had been selling her drugs during this time. She stated that she does not know her really well, that she had met her in Liberty Park and at that time she was spaced out on drugs. Debbie had approached her about purchasing drugs at that time. She stated that she had a couple of her friends check her out to see that she was not a narc, then agreed to sell her drugs.

She stated that she always came to her house, which is approximately [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. She was usually accompanied by an individual approximately 20 to 22 year old, long shoulder length blond hair, about 5'10" to 6 feet tall, husky build, quite muscular through the shoulders. She stated that the last time Debbie purchased any drugs was the night before Halloween which would have been 10-30-74. At this time, she purchased 50 hits of acid, one gram of THC, 12 mescaline and two lids of marijuana. She stated that she paid \$200.00 for these, although this is considerably less than the market value.

She stated that at that time Debbie had inquired of her as to places that she might go if she went to the California area. She stated she was having a hard time gettin along and understanding her parents. That she was scared to talk to them in regard to the drug problem she was experiencing. She felt that she had to get away. She also stated that in as much as a couple of her friends, meaning Melissa SMITH and Laura AIME had been killed that she felt this was a good time to leave. (However, at this time Debbie would not have known that Laura had left, or been killed.

Informant indicated that some of the addresses she might have gone were: [REDACTED]

Informant stated that some of the individuals living at the addresses would be Angelo Sanchez, Mark White, Sharon White, Buddy Sanchez and Jerry Burndello. (exact spelling unknown)
