Reporting Officer contacted Carbon County Sheriff's Office who informed this Officer that Mr. Carson had been a suspect in several of their rapes. He stated they were unable to make any formal charges or convictions on him as they lacked evidence to do so.

They stated that Mr. Carson's record was quite extensive in burglary, contributing, sodomy, suspect in several rapes, vagrancy and so forth. Also they stated that Mr. Carson had several entries with Salt Lake County.

Reporting Officer contacted Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office Record Division and obtained a photograph and a copy of the reports and record they had on him. The record they had indicated two counts of rape, two or three counts of burglary and other charges.

At this time the whereabouts of Mr. Carson is not known. Mr. Carson also goes by the name of Brent A. Sanders. Also has used the alias of Brent A. Carson.

The photos of Mr. Carson will be shown to the witness in an effort to either identify him or eliminate him.

She stated she had dated an individual which looked like the composite drawing in this case stating that at that time he was very brutal and rude with her in the actions he took during the evening.

She stated that he was continually hitting on her and the other parties in the crowd and that later in the evening he produced a book on how to organize militant groups and how to start riots.

She stated this individual's name was Jay Robert Greenan,

Reporting Officer contacted U.B.I. and was informed that Mr. Greenan had been arrested by B.Y.U. Security on a charge of carnal knowledge. Reporting Officer then contacted B.Y.U. Security and talked to Sgt. Turner who informed this Officer that Mr. Greenan had never been formally charged by their Department and at the time he was in the service and they dismissed the charges upon his returning to the service.

He stated he was under the impression that he had been charged by the Military Service for some other charges.

Sgt. Turner sent a copy of Mr. Greenan's fingerprints to this Department, however, stated he was unable to locate the reports on this case as they had been filed away.

Sgt. Turner stated that they did not have a picture of Mr. Greenan as they did not mug him at the time of the incident.

Reporting Officer obtained a Drivers License picture of Mr. Greenan, however, the physical description on the License does not match the composite in this case.

At this time this will complete the investigation on Mr. Greenan pending any further information that might link him back into this case.
