On 11-18-74 a Mrs. Rigby of [REDACTED] telephoned this department and advised that last Saturday, 11-16-74, she was working at Macey's Supermarket in Rose Park. She stated she was in the process of handing out samples when a party she described as having long hair, almost to the middle of the back, approached her. She stated that he was rather tall, perhaps taller than 6' 1", muscular build. She estimated his age at approximately in his twenties. She could not tell whether or not it was early twenties or late twenties.

She stated that as he left she became very suspicious of this individual and very uncomfortable. The individual she described also had a monkey bite on one side of his neck, and as she observed him leave he climbed into a grey white volkswagon. She thought the first three letters were FKD. She stated at which time he left the area.

She, in speaking with another employee, was advised by this other person that she felt the party was too young to be the suspect being sought in the Kent disappearance. However, she stated she still felt very uncomfortable. She stated the boy that checked him out had received a check from the party and the only thing she could remember was the party's last name. It was Loveless.
