This department received in anonymous phone call wherein the caller stated that if we wanted to find out where Debra KENT was, we should contact Charles LUNDQUIST, [REDACTED]. The caller stated that Mr. LUNDQUIST was the natural grandfather of Debra KENT.

I made contact at the LUNDQUIST RESIDENCE and interviewed Mr. and Mrs. Charles LUNDQUIST and his wife. According to Mr. LUNDQUIST he stated that Belva Jean KENT is his daughter and that after he and his first wife were divorced in the late 1940's, all of the children went with his ex-wife, Winona Bingham, now Winona Bingham ELLET. She is presently living in Smithfield, Utah.

He stated that there is a lot of bad blood and feelings over the divorce at the time and therefore he kind of washed his hands of the family and also of the grandchildren, and stated that he has not seen his daughter Belva nor any of his grandchildren since 1952.

He stated that the majority of this time he has lived in the Salt Lake area and that the only real problem he had shortly after his divorce, was when Winona BINGHAM took him to court over alimony that she felt he owed, claiming that he owed \$8,000.00 in back payments. He maintained that after he got married he was not required to pay alimony. He stated that they settled out of court, this being in Logan, Utah, for \$500.00, and since that date he has not seen his ex-wife, Mrs. ELLET or his daughter Belva Jean or any of their grandchildren.

I then went to the Dean KENT residence and there made contact with Mr. KENT and Mrs. KENT, who both confirmed that this was the case and indicated that since this officer had made contact with Mr. LUNDQUIST and brought this case to his attention and knowledge, he has made telephone contact and is planning on making a visit with the KENT family.

Mr. LUNDQUIST'S telephone number in Sandy is [REDACTED]

It is the feeling of this officer that one of two possibilities existed in regards to this lead, that very possibly there were still some feelings from some member of the family, who wanted to get Mr. LUNDQUIST in hot water or very possibly a member of the family felt that this was an opportunity to try and unite the family and bring them back together.

I inquired of Mrs. KENT concerning the possibility of Debra possibly going with her grandmother, Mrs. ELLET who lives in Smithfield, however I was informed by the KENT'S that the day following Debra's disappearance, 11-9-74, that they had telephoned the ELLET'S and that they have both since been with the family since that date and assisted in the search and tried to help in anyway possible.

This officer was contacted by Russ OLSEN, principal of Meadowbrook Elementary School in Bountiful wherein he was desirous of talking with the officer as he had

information concerning this case. Contact was made with Mr. OLSEN and also his custodian, Walter Craig JOHNSON, [REDACTED].

Mr. OLSEN informed this officer that he had been contacted by Mr. JOHNSON who stated that he had been doing a little digging on his own, after observing a publication in the advertiser stating that Mr. MICHAEL ANDREASEN possibly worked for the Mafia as a mechanic. He stated that this picture was quite similar to the composite which this department already has on file and indicated that in checking in the 1972 phone book, Mr. ANDREASEN lived at [REDACTED]. The current address in the new telephone book is [REDACTED].

After pointing out the changes of address to this officer and the likeness of the composite with the advertisement picture, this officer recorded this information. It is noted by this officer and also Deputy J.R. Hunt of the Davis County Sheriff's Office who assisted me on this interview, that Mr. JOHNSON himself is quite similar to the composite as he had long dark hair over the ears down to the collar, approximately 6'1", 185 pounds and had a mustache of similar likeness to the composite, therefore this officer requested that the information given by Mr. JOHNSON be taken from his drivers license so a number of questions would not have to be asked for our report.

After obtaining the drivers license information a photograph was ordered from the drivers license division in order that this also might be compared with the photographs by the witnesses.

This officer and Deputy Hunt then went to the International Institute of Hair Styling in Salt Lake where Mr. Mike ANDREASEN is currently working as a manager and owner. We briefly talked with him in order to get a better look at him in regards to prior thefts that they have had at the beauty school in Bountiful. It is our feeling that even though there is quite a likeness to the composite that Mr. ANDREASEN appeared to be older than the man described by the witnesses. However, a picture of Mr. ANDREASEN posing as a possible mechanic for the mafia in the ad, has also been placed in the mug book for comparison.

Telephone contact was made with Deputy ELY of the Summit County Sheriff's Office as this officer had received information that possibly Debra KENT was in the Park City area and this information was passed on to him. He did stated that the information given to him concerning her whereabouts on a certain street in a white colored home was very close and that they would check the area for this department. He indicated however that there was a certain individual there who did very closely match the composite that this department gave to them, his name being Ronald Dennis AUTH, DOB: [REDACTED]. That he had a girl friend by the name of Elaine who owns an

older white Volkswagen, 1967 to 68. It does have rust spots on it and a portion of the right rear seat stuffing is torn and coming out. He indicated that they would watch for this vehicle and this individual and would check on this for our department and notify us as soon as they were able to make contact.

I was contacted by Mrs. BINGHAM who stated that she was acquainted with a Mrs. Dale SARGENT and had learned from her several years before that Dale had had problems with younger girls and that this was one of the reasons they had separated. She indicated that he used to operate the Powder Puff, then moved to Roy and she thought presently he was operating Dale's Beauty Salon in Centerville. She stated that the only reason she brought this up to this department at this time is the fact that she knows that he has had problems with the younger kids in the past and had taken a fancy to them and according to her, he definitely does fit the composite of our suspect.

She was informed that this department would attempt to obtain a photograph of him and would also show this photograph to the witnesses at the school to see if we could eliminate him or keep him as a possible active suspect.

Contact was made with Mrs. Harold SCOTT, [REDACTED] who stated that on 11-16-74 while shopping at Albertsons at Pages Lane, she observed a man who was very well dressed being very nervous, who very closely resembled the composite of our suspect, standing behind her in the line at the check out stand, whom she noticed several times reading off the information on the check which she was writing to pay her groceries. She stated that he did have a mustache and slight sideburns, dark hair, kept rubbing his nose, and at the time was wearing an Indian vest, tan pants, stood about 5'8", 170 pounds. She stated that she did not wait to see the car that he got into.

She was informed that this would be checked and should she see this individual again, to recontact this department and attempt to obtain a license plate number for this agency.
