X Reporting Officer was dispatched to Viewmont High School to interview some students. They have some information concerning the disappearance of the subject in this case.

Reporting Officer interviewed the following:

Sherry stated that during the lunch hour she usually goes down to the 5th Amendment where her mother works, and gets the family car in order to obtain a ride home. However, on Wednesday as she was walking back from the 5th Amendment at approximately 1245 Hours a man in a green car asked if she wanted a ride. She stated that she would not accept the ride, ignoring the individual. Sherry stated that the composite drawing that she had seen at school this date looked very much like the individual, however, his hair was straighter and his nose a little more narrow than that showing in the composite drawing.

Reporting Officer also learned from a student that Mrs. Shepard had said the individual she observed in the hall on the night of the incident, Friday, she had remembered the suspect in the composite drawing furnished her had on the little finger of his left hand a rather large gold ring, very shiny. The ring had a large stone, possibly a diamond. Reporting Officer contacted Mrs. Shepard at the school to confirm this, and she stated that she had indeed remembered that after leaving the station. She stated the suspect did indeed have the ring on, and stated it as above.

Reporting Officer talked with [REDACTED] She stated that she was at the school the evening of Debra's disappearance. She had gone out during the performance to exercise a dog that they had there. She stated that she left putting the dog away and had gone back in. Later in talking with her brother-in-law, Orville Ryver, [REDACTED] who leaves for work in the evening before 11:00 PM. He stated that he had heard a girl screaming. No other information was furnished by [REDACTED]

Reporting Officer then talked with one [REDACTED] She stated that as she has been going home she had seen this individual, as in the composite drawing, at Bountiful Bowl. The suspect is in his thirties, is a thin to medium build, and has scared her when she had seen his picture this morning. She stated the suspect told her as she walked by that he has been watching her for the past two days and informed her he would be watching her again. Joan Argyle stated she saw this individual last at Bountiful Bowl on Saturday night at approximately 2100 Hours and at that time he was in a yellow car, make unknown.
