## DETAILS OF OFFENSE:

The reporting officer went to the Hi Club at 1550 South 500 West where I spoke with a bartender, three customers, white male Americans in the bar, on the report by the complainant that a subject looking exactly like the artist's sketch of the male suspect in the Debra KENT case, had been in the bar moments before attempting to hitchhike a ride into Salt Lake City.

However, the bartender and the customers failed to answer the description and each stated that they knew nothing of anyone attempting to get a ride.

I then went to the Hiya Club across the street from Slim Olsons, with Officer Dub Lawrence and interviewed the lady bartender and four customers who were in the bar regarding the complaint. They stated that no one there had attempted to hitchhike a ride and none of the customers resembled the artist sketch.

I then went to the FREESTONE residence and interviewed George FREESTONE and his mother, who had been at the Hi Club. She stated that there had been a subject in there attempting to get a ride but Mrs. FREESTONE seemed quite inebriated when I spoke with her and made no attempt to defend her original complaint which had been transmitted to this office by her son.

There seems to be no basis for this complaint.
