COMPLAINANT: DEAN KENT

At 1847 Hours this date we received a phone call from Juanita Fredrickson of [REDACTED] Mrs. Fredrickson advised she was watching TV this night and saw a picture of the girl who was missing and felt this girl had been to her home last evening. She described the girl as being approximately 5'2", 110 pounds wearing a short coat, hip length, believed to be corduroy, brown in color. She was wearing a blue blouse, light color with what she thought was a flower on the front. She guessed her age at about 17 years, dark brown hair possibly shoulder length and wearing levi pants.

Kevin Fredrickson described the girl as 130#, 5'6" wearing plaid corduroy coat, blue levis, giving the name of Annette. He stated the girl had been staying with one Bob Ryan but later wound up with two boys by the name of Jeff Jones and Jimmy Polder of [REDACTED]

Contact was made with Jimmy Polder, [REDACTED] and the picture was shown to him of the missing girl. He stated that there was a resemblance, however, did not think it was her. He described the girl as being rather short, overweight, 5'4" to 5'6", weighing possibly 130 to 140 pounds. She was wearing blue tennis shoes, blue levis and had short hair, brown in color and wearing tan pants. At the time she left him she was wearing a burgandy shirt, pair of blue levis and had a blouse with her that was pink and white in color. He stated the girl advised her name was Annette Stubbs from Orem, Utah and she had run away as she could not live at home any longer. She left her home last Wednesday, 11/6/74 and gave her age as being 15. She advised she had been in a mental hospital in the past at the age of 12.

Jimmy Polder stated she then went to North Ogden and supposedly had gone there to stay with a friend by the name of John Easling.

We went to North Ogden to where John Easling was supposedly staying and no address was given, only a description. His vehicle was there, however, John was not as far as we could determine. Contact was made with his parents at [REDACTED] Ogden. They advised that John seldom comes home except when he needs something such as his laundry done. In all instances when we would show the picture of the missing girl those that saw it stated they had not seen her outside of the TV Broadcast. Weber County has both the picture of the girl and the suspect composite and will continue in their efforts to locate this girl.

At this time we can neither say it is her nor eliminate her for sure.
