They stated that they had just seen the composite drawing of our suspect. They stated that this looks identical to an individual by the name of Rick Geyer, possible spelling unknown, could be Guier or Guyer. They stated that Rick is about 23 to 25 years of age. He operates a 1966 to 1967 Oldsmobile, medium sized car, medium blue in color. They stated he frequents the old Sundown Lounge on 7200 South State, the Alibi Lounge at about 7800 South State, the Little Brown Jug Lounge, location unknown and is also a member of the Sage Supper Club at about 9000 South State.

They advised this Officer he was arrested by Salt Lake County for molest some time back in July or August of this year. They were both very impressed with the composite drawing and were both certain this is the individual they know.

Mr. & Mrs. Miles stated that they would make contacts and attempt to pin-point Rick's exact name. They stated that Rick is a very flashy dresser and a smooth talking individual and does get along extremely with women.

This Officer received a phone call from a party who only identified himself as a field representative for Continental Bank. He stated he had under investigation one Terry Bangerter. He stated he went into a restaurant on 2700 East in the area of 4000 South. He stated he saw a photograph near the cash register which very closely resembled the composite drawing.

He stated he merely wanted this Department to check the possibility out.

This Officer and Sgt. Ballantyne went to the Romeo's Pizza establishment on 4010 South 2700 East and spoke to Jack Raia, the owner of the business. Mr. Bangerter's name was suggested by this Officer and Mr. Raia stated that he had a photograph somewhere, however, looking he was unable to locate the photograph.

He told these Officers that Terry has been an employee in the past year on and off and is very undependable. He states that Terry does have dark hair and a mustache and is considered very good looking by most of the customers. Mr. Raia repeatedly compared Terry's appearance to that of Mark Spitz the famous swimmer.

He stated that Terry drives a newer model MonteCarlo, possibly 1973 or 1974, white in color and he also stated that Terry is a very clean individual, a very sharp dresser, a smooth talker and gets along well with women. His age was estimated at around 25 years.

A 1970 photograph was obtained on Terry Duane Bangerter from U.B.I. The photo however is minus the long hair and mustache. The nature and extent of Terry's past record is not known at this time.

Deputy Bone from Davis County Sheriff's Office received an anonymous phone call from whom he described as being very upset. She stated she knows a person who she describes as being the person in the composite drawing. She identified the individual as Mike Roberts. She stated that Mr. Roberts works in the Murray area and is a known sex offender and has been committed previously to the State Mental Hospital in Provo for same.

This Officer contacted U.B.I. and obtained four possibles on the name of Mike Roberts.

First, Michael James Roberts, DOB: 1-6-50, WMA, 5'10", 150#, brown hair, hazel eyes. Photograph was obtained of this subject. He was arrested on 4/18/70 by Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office for Driving Under the Influence, Social Security Number is [REDACTED]. He was a student at the University of Utah in 1970.

Second, Michael Louis Roberts - alias Rossier and Hall. 5'10", 150#, blonde hair, blue eyes, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] This subject has a one page rap sheet. There was a photograph obtained of this subject. On a 1972 fingerprint card his address was listed as [REDACTED]. He did in the past work for Newell A. Nelson, a florist service. He has a sister, Judy Riley, [REDACTED] in Bountiful. He has been arrested for Burglary 2nd Degree, Grand Larceny and Forgery.

Third, Michael D. Roberts - [REDACTED] He has two arrests in California. One for forgery and one for theft of credit card. One arrest in Utah for bad checks. A 1971 address of [REDACTED] Possible employee of Ute Cab Company. No further information or photo available on this subject from U.B.I.

Fourth, Michael Bassett Roberts - [REDACTED] Salt Lake Police Department [REDACTED] - description 5'11" - 162# - brown hair - hazel eyes and resides in Salt Lake City. No further information or photograph available from U.B.I.

These are the only Michael Roberts that U.B.I. has on file.
