Mr. MAUGHAN, the principal at South Davis Junior High School called and stated that he had some information that might be of interest to those investigating the KENT case.

He stated that at 7:50 A.M. on 11-20-74 a call came into the school. A male adult voice asked for Mrs. HOLBROOK, a female P.E. teacher at the school. When Mrs. HOLBROOK got on the line the male voice stated, "You had better keep your eyes on your girls at Central Davis on Saturday." This is the only conversation which Mrs. HOLBROOK had with the caller.

Sherry HOLBROOK lives at [REDACTED]
Mr. MAUGHAN told this officer that the girls from several schools are congregating at Central Junior High School at 8:00 A.M. on Saturday for some sports events. Mr. MAUGHAN feels that something may be worth checking into at that event.

I requested that Mr. MAUGHAN notify the principals of the Junior High Schools involved to alert their respective teachers who may be involved.

This officer received a note from Officer Richey stating that Deputy Hanson from Juab County Sheriff's Office, called and stated that a Mr. TURNER from [REDACTED] Utah knows a Mike BEAN that hangs around the V Club on 3900 South State Street in Salt Lake City.

Deputy Hanson stated that Mr. TURNER says that the Mr. BEAN look identical to the suspect in the composite.
