Security that they had rec. two more complaints regarding a man in a small blue car attempting to pick up girls in the area. of the University. Earlier this date Invest. J.R. Dwyer and I had talked with two other Univ. students who also had the same trouble with a man in a small blue car license number OF3780. We checked the data and learned the car was registered to a Robert Martorella of 316 Roberts Ave. DOB [REDACTED] for a blue 1972 VW. Also learned that this man was a mailman and on checking the Post Office learned he was off today and was not at home.

At 2345Hrs. contacted the YD and Invest. L. Felber & Davis went to the home of Martorella and brought him to the Youth Div. I contacted the above two girls and also brought them to the YD where they looked at Martorella and the Rosenbaum girl stated this was the man who gave her a ride on Sat. 11 Nov. 72 and while she was in the car he grabbed her leg and asked her if he could kiss her. Miss. Rosenbaum stated she did not wish to prosecute suspect. Also the the other girls who reported this blue car stated they did not wish to prosecute. [REDACTED] who was with the above victim when she met man who [REDACTED] at the Upstate# Medical stated this was not the man. Returned the girls to their Dorms. Questioned Martorella with Invest. M. Mahady and he admitted that for the past couple of months he has been going to the Univer. area during the day and attempting to pick up girls. He also admitted picking up the Rosenbaum girl and grabbing her by the leg and attempting to kiss her. He stated that he is

Reidy received a call from Bill Quackenbush, F.B.I. agent who related the following information which he received from private Inves John Begley. Begley stated he interviewed a Rosaland E. Brown [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Phone [REDACTED] Cortland State Colage. She stated she advertised for a ride at the collage and was called by Bill Grace who told her he would take her to Philadelphia or any place she wanted to go. Grace is supposed to work at Prudential Life Ins. Co. Cortland N. Y. We calleed Chief Kingsly Cortland Police who stated he had a picture of Grace in a year book of South Lansing N. Y. Invest. M. Mahady and Inves. L. Felber took the witnesses to Tuly where we met Chief Kingsly and showed them the Pictures. Witness Paula Lippen and Mitchel Sakofs both stated that the picture of Bill Grace fit the suspects discription. We returned back to Y.D. and had the picture blown up by our lab. When they were shown the blown up picture they both were fairly certain this was the man. and requested the picture be blown up more. They both stated that the picture looked more like the man they saw at the hospital the night in question. When shown the double enlargement of subject William Grace [REDACTED] stated that Grace was the man she saw at Upstate Hospital 10 Nov 72 with [REDACTED].

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With Inv. J. Janiak this date met Mr. John Begley and Chris Satow employees of Britton Ass. Inc. as private investigators. These men have been hired by the parents of [REDACTED] and are conducting an investigation regarding her disappearance. They gave us a copy of their findings.

[REDACTED], [REDACTED] s roommate and her boyfriend Mitchel Sokofs of Cortland State were questioned by Begley and Satow and viewed some pictures at the Upstate Med. Center of employees. They picked out a picture of a man resembling the person they saw [REDACTED] leave with. The person's name is Robert E. Burghardt of 3349 1/2 LaFayette Rd. Jamesville N.Y. dob [REDACTED] A check of our records disclosed that Burghardt had been a suspect in a case involving young girls in Nov 69 but the DA refused to issue a warrant. Went to the Upstate Med Ctr. and spoke Mr. Newton the maintenance supervisor, who stated that Burghardt had been employed there but was terminated on the 7th of April, 1971, because of his actions pertaining to girls and women (exposure, etc.).

A Motor Vehicle check on OY-8913 which had been registered to Burghardt had expires in May of 1971. Teletype sent for MV check at this time also a check at Oneida State Police showed his last address as being 127 Cannon St. Syracuse, N.Y. on an expired registration. Went to 127 Cannon St. no answer. A check at the Post Office disclosed a change of address for Burghardt from 127 Cannon St. to 42 Elm St. Tully, N.Y. Contacted Lafayette State Police BCI Agent John Bryant and requested a check at that address for this party. Upon receiving the teletype reply from Albany regarding data for any auto registered
