The two vehicles that they had registered are as follows: a green 1973 Volkswagen IDD-828, purchased from Moore Motors on 9-20-73 and financed through Seattle 1st National Bank. The title was cleared on 6-26-74. The other vehicle is a 1974 Chevrolet pickup PC-6537, 1974 registration, was purchased on 5-28-74 from Alley Chevrolet in Seattle and financed through King County Employees Credit Union. Another vehicle has been re-registered in the State of California.

60 3-21-75 1500 hrs.: Called DETECTIVE DON CAMERON, SPD Homicide, 583-2340, to review the KAREN LEE SPARKS Assault Case which occurred on 1-4-74 in the 4200 block on 8th NE. He said that she is progressing fine and that he would call the father, LESLIE SPARKS, home phone CH 4-5890, business phone 767-5657 to arrange for a sodium pentothal test - evidently the victim's memory is blank from a short time before the assault to a few days after the assault and she does not remember who assaulted her. Her neuro-surgeon said that possibly sodium pentothal might bring this information for them. SPARKS will call the office to set up an appointment.

61 3-24-75 0930 hrs.: Called ERNIE RICE who is a security guard at the 6001 Apts., 885-7122 - he said that FAUST And GOSSETT have five vehicles associated with their apt. #197. RICE said that he did not know either FAUST or GOSSETT personally and does not know if they may be gay. The five vehicles associated with their apartment are CNZ 171, SBA 581, WWZ 033, DGW 567 and DHT 390.

62 1515 hrs.: Phone call from SGT. BILL BALDRIDGE, Pitkin County Sheriff's Office in Aspen, Colorado, P/N 303-925-3232. He has been investigating a homicide wherein HUGH J. TEMOS, DOB 5-26-43 is a spouse. He was arrested by SPD for Indecent Liberties and booked on K.C.#91861. We had previously checked out TEMOS and this investigation positively eliminated him as a suspect. BALDRIDGE said that TEMOS may now be driving Washington plated car ALK 357 which is registered to RUDOLPH ARNDT of 311 NW 77th. BALDRIDGE went on to say that Vale, Colorado is now investigating the disappearance of JULIE CUNNINGHAM who is a ski instructress at Vale, Colorado - she disappeared 8 days ago without a grace. She fits the physical description of all the missing girls - attractive, 5'5", 112 lbs. long brown hair parted in the middle. BALDRIDGE requested that the registered owner of ALK 357 be contacted for any possible leads to his case.

63 1520 hrs.: Olympia registration on ALK 357 shows that it is a 68 registration on a 55 Ford Fairlane 4 dr. to RUDOLPH ARNDT, of 311 NW 77th.

4 1600 hrs.: Called RUDOLPH ARNDT, 782-1456 - he said that he sold

He said that he sent out many invitations but he doesn't know who will be attending the conference so to enlist the aid of departments that will be attending the conference will be futile because he doesn't know who will attend and who will not. 95 3-31-75 0955 hrs.: LINDA DRAHN called the office and said she will come in at 1000 hrs. on 4-1-75.

96 4-1-75 1015 hrs.: LINDA DRAHN who lives at 1212 SW 170th, Seattle, home P/N 243-1922, came to the office for an interview with DET. KEPPEL and me. She last heard from JANICE OTT at approximately 1700 to 1800 hrs. on 7-13-74. JAN called her and wanted to go out dancing. LINDA thought this strange because she had never requested this before and due to the fact that JAN was married, it surprised her. LINDA got the impression that JAN wanted to go dancing in the University District. They talked for about half an hour but JANICE didn't mention if JIM had called by that time or not. JAN seemed in high spirits and didn't speak of her plans for the following day. LINDA worked at the Youth Center from May 1973 through May of 1974 and this is when she became friends with JAN. LINDA had visited JIM and JANICE when they lived in the apartment house in the 4300 block on Brooklyn Ave. NE. Their apartment was very tidy and she met some of their other friends but she cannot recall what their names were. JANICE didn't speak of being unfaithful to JIM or of having extramarital affairs but LINDA left for a vacation in Hawaii approximately the first part of June and returned approximately the week before JAN disappeared. They spoke on the phone and JAN seemed to have become distant. She was living with BETTY STOVER at the time. JAN did mention JIM bugged her because he was so rational and methodical. JAN was very outgoing and would do things on the spur of the moment where JIM would not. JIM would go through great periods of silence and this would bug JAN. She would be embarrassed because she would have to keep the conversation going. JAN mentioned that approximately 7 or 8 months after they were married, JIM mentioned he might want to go out with other girls and this seemed to shock JAN. LINDA's opinion of JIM OTT was that he was a stick-in-the-mud and she did not particularly like JIM and she didn't think that he and JAN made a very good couple. She did not know if JIM could possibly be gay or if JAN may have participated in Lesbian activities. She did not know if JIM were in the habit of going to Eastern Washington or Oregon without JAN. She said that JAN told her on 7-13-74 that she had been out on 7-12-74 with some guy but LINDA did not know who it was, or could not remember.

97 1130 hrs.: DET. DON CAMERON, SPD Homicide called to say that their assault victim KAREN SPARKS had recovered from her assault and is presently going to school at the University of Washington. She gets home

- DAILY at 1430 hrs. She and her family are very concerned about the assault and want to assist with hyp notism or sodium pentothal treatments in hopes of gaining any information about a possible suspect in her case which may relate to LYNDIA ANNE HEALY.
- 98 4-2-75 0845 hrs.: Called DR. RALPH M. STOLZHEISE at 323-8788 whose office space is at 900 Boylston Ave., Suite #3. An appointment was made for KAREN SPARKS for 4-9-75 at 1530 hrs. He had requested a copy of the case.
- 99 1100 hrs.: Called DET. CAMERON and he will notify the SPARKS' family of the scheduled appointment.
- 100 4-3-75 1430 hrs.: I took a copy of the SPARKS' case to DR. STOLZHEISE.
- 101 4-4-75 1330 hrs.: Detectives investigating the case met with psychiatrists and psychologists to go over the case. These people included DR. JOE SIMONDS, DR. JOHN BIBBERICH, DR. JOHN LIEBERT, DR. DONNA SCHRAMM; CAPT. SWINDLER and DET. POINDEXTER of SPD were also present. We discussed the cult theory and the possibility of a cult activity. The general consensus among the doctors was that it was not cult activity, rather one or possibly two individuals.
- 102 4-5-75 1245 hrs.: I arrived at LaConner, Wa. for the RANCOURT Memorial Service which was conducted at the Methodist Church at LaConner. While waiting to enter the church I noticed an odd acting individual who had also been at the BRENDA BALL memorial service which was held in Burien on 3-11-75. I shook this man down and he identified himself as WILLIAM P. LLOYD, lives at 1119 166th SE, Bellevue, Wa. Home P/N SH 6-0755, 5'10" 170 lbs. receding gray hair and icy blue eyes. He said his purpose for attending the services was out of compassion for the victims and to approach the families about a large reward to bring forward information about the killers. He is convinced that more than one person is involved, and has spoken with RICK MILLER at the Beltane bookstore in the University about the possibility of cult activity being responsible for the girls' disappearance. He said that MILLER told him there was a cult operating in Duvall and one of the principals in the cult is LLOYD CABLE. It should be noted that LLOYD checks clear county records, SPD records, Sea-King system and in the mental patient printout that we received from the Dept. of Social and Health Services. He appears to be concerned about the victims but appears to be somewhat of an eccentric. At the memorial service I also met CHIEF AL PICKLES and CHERYL MARTIN of Central Washington State College and SGT. L. BEMIS of Snohomish County Sheriff's Office. SGT. BEMIS has been designated the "TED" coordinator for Snohomish County Sheriff's Office. The memorial service lasted approximately one hour, there were approximately 200 people in attendance. The service went without incident. MR. and MRS. RANCOURT are leaving to go back to Alaska on 4-6-75, their home address is 834 N. Lane Street, Apt. #10, Anchorage, Alaska, P/N there is 274-2827.

ITEM:

- 103 4-6-75 1000 hrs.: DR. JOE SIMONDS requested to go to the Taylor Mountain site for his impressions. We drove up Taylor Mountain and checked out the area.
- 104 4-8-75 1400 hrs.: Received information back from DMV on CHARLES T. ATKINS, DOB 2-28-29, REX R. FAUST, DOB 1-12-13, ROBERT S. GOSSETT, DOB 3-14-49, DAVID J. MORRIS, DOB 7-29-27, and LLOYD J. WARNER, DOB 5-24-17. All these individuals are registered owners of vehicles associated with WILLIAM FAUST's apartment at the 6001 Apts. A photo of ROBERT GOSSETT was included to be shown to witnesses as a possible TED suspect - all the others have been eliminated.
- 105 4-9-75 0900 hrs.: The Task Force went to Lake Sammamish Park to familiarize everyone with the area.
- 106 1000 hrs.: Went to the Issaquah scene and while driving to Taylor Mt., clocked the mileage as 7.1 miles from the Issaquah scene to the intersection of I-90 and Hwy. 18, and from I-90 to Taylor Mt. it is 4.1 miles.
- 07 1215 hrs.: We arrived at the Taylor Mt. site.
- 08 1230 hrs.: While going through the area I found two bones which were located 35 feet, 1 inch west of 1000/1000 on string line 50. They were photographed with a Polaroid by DET. KIDD and packaged as evidence item #R-96, at 1300 hrs.
- 109 1530 hrs.: KAREN SPARKS went to DR. STOLZHEISE for her hypnotic session, accompanied by her father.
- 110 4-10-75 1000 hrs.: I placed evidence item #R-96 into evidence with K. SWEENEY.
- 111 1200 hrs.: I called DR. STOLZHEISE who said that chances are about 50-50. She was able to recall a little information while hypnotized and DR. STOLZHEISE will hypnotize her one more time next week then try sodium pentothal on her to try to bring forward any information.
- 112 Summary: Data on suspects and license plates are received daily and put on TED forms and follow-up. To date 2,200 suspects have been checked out and approximately 900 vehicles. Of these all but 50 individuals have been positively eliminated either through photographs and/or positively being located elsewhere at the time of any of the girls' disappearance. The investigation is continuing.

- 93 From 1973 to March 1974 a HOWARD BARKHOFF lived at 4328 8th NE. He is a young man working now for Greenlake Cycle as a bicycle mechanic. He may shed some light on activities in the neighborhood at that time. Greenlake Cycle is located at 7007 Woodlawn NE, P/N 523-1822.
- 94 Prior to March 73, DEAN SILVERSTONE used to run a print shop at 901 NE 45th. He had a Mexican male named JOSE who caused trouble and was the reason SILVERSTONE's lease was not renewed. JOSE can be located through SILVERSTONE who now lives in Bellevue and is a boxing/wrestling promoter.
- 95 MRS. KALBERG's son was not at her home; he lives at 7171 Beach Dr. SW, P/N WE 7-0805. She is not sure if her son would have additional information.
- 96 7-24-75 0930 hrs.: Called GINGER HEATH - she does not recall any of the men that DET. McCHESNEY received from MRS. HERRON as living next door. She recalls a guy named JEFF and his brother, FRED.
- 97 1420 hrs.: Called DAVID GEHRKE, 523-1915. GEHRKE matched on computer's check as being in LYNDIA HEALY's address book and also as being stopped by WSP in the month of April in Ellensburg.
- 98 GEHRKE related that his former girlfriend, KAREN HENDERSON, had introduced DAVE PELLIS to LYNDIA. He never was at LYNDIA's house prior to her disappearance. He had seen LYNDIA on campus the Monday before her disappearance and LYNDIA complained of a guy who was hanging around. She didn't mention his name.
- 99 GEHRKE related that he and a friend had skipped school and gone fishing on opening day in April of 1974 and his car broke down between Ellensburg and Vantage. The WSP had helped him start his car. This would have been 4 days after RANCOURT's disappearance. Roommates who lived with GEHRKE who knew LYNDIA were DICK SHEARER and JOHN COBURN. DICK had been to LYNDIA's house prior to her disappearance. For further information on GEHRKE, see TED file. GEHRKE is not considered a match at this time for investigation purposes.
- 100 7-28-75 0900 hrs.: BRUCE COUGAN reported for polygraph exam. He is the boyfriend of KAREN SPARKS, victim of assault in U District on January 4, 1974. Results indicated that COUGAN was not attempting deception to relevant questions.
- 101 1000 hrs.: Called BRUCE PARKER, 522-8684, he lived at 5519 12th NE at the time of LYNDIA HEALY's disappearance. Also living there were CHARLES ADRIANSE, STEVE WAGENER. CHARLES PACKER, and DENNIS ANDERSON. He recalls that on January 31, 1974, all
