Dear Sirs:

On November 1, 1978, the above homicide occurred in our city. The above suspect has developed in this case. Lucas is currently incarcerated in Georgetown, Texas for murder and is claiming he has murdered approximately twelve females in Washington and Oregon states.

Comparisons of Lucas's blood analysis to blood found at this crime scene has not eliminated him as a suspect. Also a synopsis given by Lucas of a homicide he clamis to have committed in this area is very similar to this homicide.

Several letters have previously been submitted in this case.

Please conduct the following examinations

Compare known fingerprints of Henry Lee Lucas, on file, with identifiable latents from the existing exhibits submitted earlier in the Lisa Martini case.

We realize the results of this examination can be used only in criminal prosecution.
