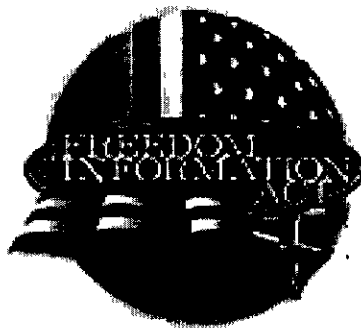


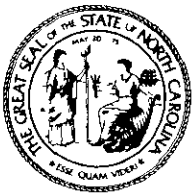

Victim was found in a ditch in Currituck County, North Carolina. Victim resided in Norfolk, Virginia.

Victim had been stabbed repeatedly. Examination of vaginal specimens collected from the victim revealed the presence of spermatozoa.

Suspect has been developed recently and hair samples have been obtained for comparison to previous results issued by Agent of the hair analysis section.

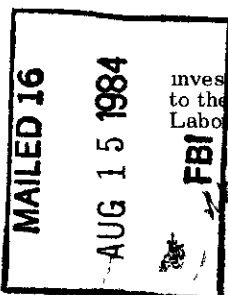

- Q1 Hair from victim's pants (A1a)
- Q2 Hair from victim's sweater (A12)
- K1 Head hair sample from victim (A3g)
- K2 Pubic hair sample from victim (A3h)

Result of examination:

Specimen Q1 consists of a single unpigmented head hair of Caucasian origin. This head hair has a bluish tint which is sometimes observed in hairs from older persons. The Q1 hair is microscopically different from the K1 head hairs from the victim and did not originate from her. It is suitable for comparison purposes and has been mounted on a glass microscope slide.

No hairs microscopically different from the K1 head hairs from the victim were found in specimen Q2.

The submitted items and the glass microscope slides are being returned to your office under separate cover by registered mail.

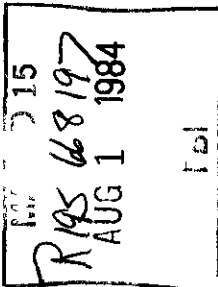
