Title: FINDINGS OF THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR

GENERAL (OIG) DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, CRITICAL OF FORENSIC WORK PERFORMED

BY CERTAIN LAB EXAMINERS

Synopsis: To place this document on record in the Task Force control file and to place a copy on the top serial in every investigative file containing forensic work performed by any of the thirteen Laboratory Examiners whose scientific work was criticized by the OIG.

Reference: 66F-HQ-A1211968 Serial 82

Details: BE ADVISED, one or more of the Laboratory Examiners who performed scientific analysis in this investigation was criticized in the OIG's report issued on April 15, 1997. The OIG conducted a thorough review of allegations of wrongdoing and improper practices within certain sections of the FBI Laboratory. It issued a report which, among other findings, was critical of the scientific work performed by thirteen individual examiners assigned to the Lab. The allegations and criticisms concerning these individuals varies greatly and in some instances is case specific.

If the forensic work contained in this file is used in any way in the future, both the OIG's findings and the forensic analysis of the examiners should be reviewed. In addition, legal advice should be obtained as to the FBI's disclosure obligations.



During telephone conversations with the Reno, Nevada, Resident Agency and conversations with the San Diego, California, Police Department Detectives, it has been determined that there may have been pine needles in the clothing at Reno, Nevada, and the fact that the victim is blond, it is noted that among evidence obtained by are b7C some samplings of pine needles or green shrub material. Also obtained by was a small bindle containing hairs off the front seat. There was also a bindle containing red shrub material found on the front floor of the vehicle. Hair and Fiber Unit is requested to conduct any logical comparison of items found in San Diego with items retrieved in bag containing victim's clothing, among which might be considered are analysis of the bindle of red shrub material as to possible origin, comparison of hair fibers found in the vehicle at San Diego with hair fibers found at the Reno, Nevada, crime scene and comparison of pine needles or green shrub material obtained from the vehicle at San Diego, California, with that allegedly obtained among victim's clothing.



Result of examination:

Light brown to brown head hairs exhibiting Caucasian characteristics were found on or in specimens Q2, Q5 through Q8, Q11, Q12, Q16, Q22 and Q26. Blond to red blond puble hairs, also exhibiting Caucasian characteristics, were found on specimens Q8 and Q12. Dark brown head hairs exhibiting Negroid characteristics were found in the debris from specimens Q5 through Q7 and Q11. Many of the above hairs are suitable for significant comparison purposes in the event known hair samples are submitted.

No other human hairs suitable for significant comparison purposes were found on or in specimens Ql through Q26.

Pine needle debris was included in specimens Q3, Q14 through Q16, Q21 through Q24 and Q26. Although the above-described debris is too limited to identify to species type, similarities were noted between the debris from Q3 and the debris from Q23.

No seeds like those included in Q2 were found in the debris from specimens Q16 through Q26.

It was determined that the Q25 string and the Kl string are dissimilar.

No transfer of textile fibers was found between the clothing of the suspect (Items Q12 through Q15) and the clothing from the victim (Items Q16 through Q24).

Semen containing spermatozoa, male reproductive cells, was identified on Q19 and Q22. Grouping tests conducted on those stains containing semen indicated the presence of the "A" factor. No semen was found on Q5 through Q10, Q12, Q13, Q16 through Q18, Q20, Q21, or Q23.

Specimen Q4 consists of three tar-coated rock fragments. Tar-coated rocks are very common on roadways. Specimen Q4, therefore, is of no value for comparison purposes.







UNKNOWN SUBJECT (S); LISA BONHAM - VICTIM

At approximately 5:00 PM, on September 3, 1977, Lisa's clothing was found in a trash can in a brown paper bag at a rest stop near Verdi, Nevada. Also in the bag was a piece of twine, and some pine needles. Examination of the clothing by the FBI Laboratory determined semen stains were on Lisa's shirt, and stockings. It was also learned that the unknown Subject is an "A" type secreter. All of Lisa's clothing was recovered, however, an ankle bracelet bearing her name was never found.

On November 13, 1977, two hikers located a jaw bond in a densely wooded area three miles into California (near Verdi, Nevada), in the Toiyabe National Park. Examination by the Rend Deputy Coroner and a dentist confirmed through X-ray that the jaw was that of Lisa. A complete search of the area located the scatter remains of Lisa. Animals had devoured her flesh leaving her bones scattered about the hillside where she was placed. The cause of death has not been determined at the present time. The Reno Deputy Coroner is unable to determine if the body was mutilated.

The area in which Lisa's remains were found is called the "Old Dog Valley Road." The actual name for the road is Sierra County, California, Route \$60. It is believed that the unknown subject who abducted Lisa had a good knowledge of the area because of the remoteness of the area. Lisa's remains were located approximately 100 yards off the road up a very steep hill. Her body was hidden under a dense growth of Manzanita bush. Since the abduction, the Manzanita has lost its foliage, and it appears as if she was hidden beneath the bush when it had leaves.





b70	The evidence in this case, RPD 412 I 77, murder of Lisa Bonham is resubmitted for laboratory analysis by the FBI lab for the following the reasons: During the course of the investigation Suspect was developed. During the course of the investigation human hairs were located within the vehicle of not originating from that person. During earlier investigative phases of this case the remains of Victim Bonham were located in a rural area of Washoe County. During the course of the remains' recovery the Victim's hair was also recovered for evidence. The Victim's hair was never compared to the hair in the vehicle for any possible match.
b7C	Also during earlier investigation a baq containing the clothing of the Victim was located in a rural area of Washoe County separate from the body recovery site. Human hairs were noted about these items of clothing. The Victim's hair was never compared to these standards to determine if it was in fact the Victim's own hair or possibly evidence relating to Suspect(s). In addition, latent fingerprints were found upon the bag and items of non-clothing nature contained within the bag. The bag was handled and contents were handled by finders of this item along with several police officers. Elimination prints and resultant elimination examinations on these latent fingerprints were never conducted. Elimination prints have since been obtained from the persons involved in handling of these evidence. It is also noted that this crime occurred in 1977, and that the state of the art in latent fingerprint development including the techniques of laser print development did not exist at time of the original laboratory analysis. The items are resubmitted for more sophisticated means of latent print development and any possible comparison to Suspect(s) and for elimination purposes also. Reports also indicate that major case prints were never compared on Suspect to on-file latent prints.
C	Recently investigating officers have learned that possible Suspect Henry Lucas has been positively identified for the murder of a person in Davis, California, on the date following the Lisa Bonham murder in Reno. Lucas has been sought, identified, and has confessed to this offense. Investigators in Davis, California, received a valid confession containing numerous polygraph keys to the offense. Lucas has admitted that he traveled to Davis, California, from Reno, Nevada, on Interstate 80 and therefore by his own admissions placed himself within Reno during very close time proximity to the Lisa Bonham murder. It should also be noted that the Victim's body and clothing, which were found in vastly separate locations, were both located along Interstate 80, a primary route to Davis. California. Lucas admitted that he was in the company of possible Suspect during the commission of the Davis, California, murder. It should be noted that Type A secretor semen containing spermatozoa were noted on the Victim's clothing. Subject is a Type A secretor who does emit sperm into his semen. The head hairs noted by the FBI upon the Victim's clothing were light brown to brown Caucasian


Investigating officers have also been in contact with the San Luis Obispo Police Department investigators where Henry Lucas has admitted to a 1980 double murder of two young female juvenile subjects. Subject Lucas has confessed to the offense which the investigators have deemed a valid confession due to the presence of numerous polygraph kevs to the offense, and that Lucas had also implicated Subject within this offense. The details of this murder contain numerous similar elements to the murder of Victim Lisa Bonham.

In summary, the state of the art has advanced far beyond the capabilities in 1977 at time of initial evidence examination, and for that reason evidence is to be resubmitted. Elimination prints were never submitted. The Victim's own head hairs were never compared for possible elimination. New suspects, Lucas and have been developed since time of initial evidence submission and are sent for comparision. As you are aware we have been in contact on numerous occasions reference the re-opening of this murder case, and the reasons for resubmission of evidence. It is requested these items be submitted to the FBI Laboratory in a timely fashion, and the results of requested examinations reported back to investigating officer as soon as possible so that additional follow-up made be conducted as is required pertinent to the results of these examinations.
