

On March 18, 1980, the First Federal Savings and Loan Association, 3801 South Clack, Abilene, Texas, was robbed by an unknown person (s), who apparently entered the office between 10:50 a.m. and 11:20 a.m. and murdered Lynn Gray, Loan Processor, who was alone in the office at that time. Another employee, had departed the office for lunch at approximately 10:50 a.m., leaving Gray alone. Gray's body was found by a delivery boy at approximately 11:20 a.m., lying face down behind the counter with a single bullet wound in the back of the head. The cash drawers were apparently ransacked and was missing.

The savings and loan building is a temporary structure located in a remote location near a new shopping center on a one way access road. The temporary office opened in January, 1980 and had no alarm system or cameras at the time of the robbery. Bank officials indicated they were in the process of negotiating for an alarm system at the time of the robbery.



HENRY LEE LUCAS; ROBBERY OF FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, 3801 South Clack, Abilene, Texas, March 18, 1980, BANK ROBBERY

On March 18, 1980, Henry Lee Lucas entered the temporary location of First Federal Savings and Loan Association, 3801 South Clack, Abilene, Texas, which was then attended by victim teller, Lynn Gray, who was alone in captioned financial institution at the time of robbery. Cash drawers were apparently ransacked and Gray was murdered, execution style, with a bullet wound in the back of the head. Total loss to the financial institution was L bait bills. including

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The savings and loan building was a temporary structure located in a then remote location near a new shopping center on a one way access road. The temporary office opened in January, 1980, and had no alarm system or cameras at the time of the robbery.

On October 4, 1983, the Abilene, Texas Police Department (APD) advised Special Agents of the FBI at Abilene, Texas, that Henry Lee Lucas, a self-confessed mass murderer presently incarcerated at Montague, Texas, had confessed to the captioned robbery-murder. Detectives from APD advised that on July 28, 1983, captioned subject had provided a sworn written statement admitting sole responsibility for captioned matter. The sworn statement of captioned subject to police contained numerous specific details, knowledge of which could only have been possessed by a person who committed captioned robbery. In referring to victim teller's death Lucas stated, "I was standing close and holding the gun about 12 inches from her head. I heard a noise that scared me and just reflexes, I fired. The gun had a hair trigger and just went off...I don't think she ever knew what hit her."

The APD advised it would file murder and aggravated robbery charges against Lucas in reference to captioned matter in near future.

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

AUSA deferred prosecution to state authorities citing the greater latitude of penalties available as a result of the murder prosecution by state authorities.





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
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
