Victim, white male, DOB 9/25/05, a night security police officer employed at Beebe, Arkansas, since 8/3/76, was fatally injured by being hit on the head with a blunt instrument approximately twenty-seven times when he apparently discovered a burglary in progress at a drug store at Beebe, Arkansas. His duties included checking all downtown stores on a shift from midnight to 6:00 AM.

On the morning of 4/5/77, victim was at the Police Department at Beebe, Arkansas, and left at approximately 4 AM. At 4:30 AM he was observed by a local paper delivery boy in downtown Beebe bleeding from the head and staggering on the street. Chief of Police, Beebe, Arkansas, called and responded to where victim was staggering on street. Victim taken to police department and while being transported to local hospital died en route approximately two Mours later. Blood stains on street indicate victim was assaulted in an alley behind the drug store and staggered for one or two blocks before being found. A large pool of blood was found in alley behind drug store along with victim's hat, which is being forwarded, and his glasses. Victim's gum was missing from his holster. An unknown quantity of drugs is missing from the drug store.

Autopsy by medical examiner indicated victim struck on head with possibly a tire tool and some type of possible paint elements were embedded in victim's skull.

Arkansas State Police conducted homicide investigation and have requested examinations by FBI Laboratory.

### REQUEST OF FBI LABORATORY

The FBI Laboratory is requested to conduct the following examinations:

- 1. Ascertain if hair samples in enclosed items 2, 3, 5, 7, 11, and 13 match that of victim's hair, which is item #1.
- 2. Determine if blood in enclosed items 3, 5, 13, 19, 21, 22, 23, and 24 is all of the same type. It is noted item 9 is sample of blood from pool of blood where victim believed initially assaulted in alley.

- 3. Examine enclosed item 8 for saliva test for blood type and ascertain if different blood type than in sample submitted.
- 4. Examine victim's cap, item 14, to ascertain if any paint element or anything else of value embedded in fabric.

### REQUEST OF IDENTIFICATION DIVISION, LATENT FINGERPRINT

Examine enclosed items 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 20 for any latent fingerprints.

Victim's clothing is forthcoming when fabric has dried to compare with enclosed items 4 and 6.

Upon completion of examinations furnish results to Little Rock Office and Arkansas State Police, Attention Investigator P. 0. Box 4005, Little Rock, Arkansas 72203.

On the weekend of 4/9/77, a burglary occurred at Gwatney Chevrolet Company, Jacksonville, Arkansas, and a safe was removed from the Chevrolet Company. Jacksonville, Arkansas, is located just south of Beebe, Arkansas. The safe from this Chevrolet burglary was recovered several miles from the Chevrolet company and under the safe was a tire tool which is enclosed. Police officers investigating the burglary stated apparently the burglars involved in the Chevrolet company burglary cut themselves during the process of removing the safe inasmuch as fresh blood was around the safe. Other than fresh blood appearing on the tire tool, investigating officers felt that there was some old blood on this tire tool and inasmuch as it appeared a tire tool may have been used to kill victim in instant case, this tire tool was kept for examination.

### REQUEST OF THE FBI LABORATORY

- 1. Examine blood stains on tire tool submitted under separate cover and ascertain blood type of what appears to be fresh blood and old blood stains on the tire tool.
- 2. Ascertain if blood type on this tire tool is the same as blood type from victim which is on victim's clothing submitted under separate cover.
- 3. Examine fur collar for any metal or paint elements that may have become detached from instrument used to beat victim.
- 4. Ascertain if blood type in all of victim's clothing is of the same type.



#### Result of examination:

Numerous brown to white head hairs of Caucasian origin that have been forcibly removed from the scalp were found in and on Q1, Q2, Q4, Q6 and Q10. These hairs exhibit the same microscopic characteristics as hairs present in the K1 hair sample and, accordingly, probably originated from the victim.

It should be noted that hair comparisons do not constitute a basis for positive personal identification.

Specimen Q9 contains a head hair (with root) that measures approximately 10 inches in length and a head hair fragment (no root) that measures approximately 2 inches in length. Both of these hairs exhibit Caucasian characteristics and both hairs exhibit the same individual microscopic characteristics. Therefore, it was concluded that both of these hairs probably originated from the same source. These hairs are dissimilar to the hairs present in K1 and did not originate from the victim.

The textile fibers in Q3 and Q5 are triacetate fibers that microscopically appear to have originated from a common source. These fibers were compared with the clothing from the victim (PBI Laboratory submission PC-N4398 TK LY MC) and it was determined that these triacetate fibers did not originate from the victim's clothing.

Group "A" human blood was identified on specimens Q4, Q8, Q13 and Q16. Grouping tests conducted on the human blood identified on specimen Q2 were inconclusive. Human blood, too limited in amount for grouping purposes, was identified on specimens Q10, Q14 and Q15. No blood was found on specimen Q12.







#### Result of examination:

Group "A" human blood was identified on specimens Q17 and Q19 through Q21. Grouping tests conducted on human blood identified on Q22 were inconclusive. Blood, too limited in amount for further characterization, was identified on Q18.

Specimen Q21 and the debris obtained by shaking and scraping this item were examined. The Q21 debris contained a few small paint particles composed essentially of a dark green wrinkle finish top coat over a black primer. These paint particles were different from foreign gray paint on the Q22 tire tool.

metallic enamels and allowing them to air-flash a few minutes before spraying them lightly with solvent in fairly large droplets at low pressure with a special gua. The solvent droplets spread out on the surface, partly solvated the coating, and produced the hammered appearance. This, of course, was essentially a two-coat system that required considerable skill of application.

Modern hammer finishes are specially formulated to give the hammered effect in one spray coat. The most commonly used vehicles are the styrenated alkyd resins Typical formulas are given in 18 and 19.

#### Wrinkle fluisbes

--

Wrinkle finishes, as the name implies, dry to a wrinkled appearance rather than to the smooth uniform surface of most industrial finishes. They are applied in thick films which are formulated to skin-dry quickly but remain soft underneath until baked. The subfilm, which contracts in the baking process, produces the wrinkled effect in the outer skin.

Wrinkle finishes are widely used on instruments, appliances, business machines and filing cabinets. When properly made and applied, they form tength, abrasion-resistant, one-coat surfaces that hide minor substrate defects such as file marks. They have an attractive, satin finish, and their coats of more than 2-mil dry-film thickness give protection for years to equipment in constant use.

Wrinkle finishes are generally applied by spraying. They are allowed to arrive for a while to harden the skin and are then baked for thorough trying.

Many factors, such as type of vehicle, pigment-binder ratio, type and amount of drier, application viscosity, and air-dry time, affect the wrinkle pattern. Most users demand a fine, uniform pattern and a fairly low gloss.

Wrinkle finishes are made from specially cooked liquids containing tung or ottoica oils Varnishes of about 25-gal. oil length, consisting of modified phenolic resin in tung oil, are fairly representative. Wrinkle-type alkyd resins containing tung or oiticica are also widely used. These finishes are usually heavily loaded with cobalt drier to produce the fast skin drying necessary for the wrinkled effect (Formula 20).

#### Crystallizing finishes

Enamel-type crystallizing finishes are made by adding raw tung oil to alkyd or oleoresinous enamels. When air-dried or baked at around 150°F., the tung oil gives the finish a "frosted" or crystallized appearance. Further baking at around 250°F, serves to harden the films in a uniform crystallized pattern




