Chemical processing of the above evidence with the use of ninhydrin reveals, Some ridge detail in the upper right hand corner of photograph, also some ridge detail in bottom middle area of photograph, but, nothing of value that could be used for a comparison. Examination and evaluation of partial latents developed on back side of photograph reveals, many partials and partial palm prints of value for comparisons.
