Continuation of narrative, #15. On arriving, the parents were asked to go upstairs to the lounge while we waited for Dr. Moore to get there. [Redacted] Private Medical

[Redacted] Private Medical About 30 minutes later, after conferring with Dr. Moore, the parents were asked to come down to the morgue viewing room and see if they could make identification. The father went in first and immediately identified the body and verified the scars on the left arm that he had described earlier. He (the father) was extremely upset, mostly because of the condition of the body with the visible bruises and marks. He said there was no doubt that this was Laura Ann Aime, his daughter. He discouraged his wife from looking at the body. Accordingly, she did not view it. [Redacted] Private Medical

[Redacted] Private Medical When they were contacted, they could find no record of the blood type.

Investigation is continuing with 1J16 and 1J20 checking out people in the American Fork area where the girl had stayed with friends.

Marty Sherran contacted me (1J1) this morning and said that he had picked Laura Aime up in Aug. of this year as a runaway. She was staying in the "Woods" back of Morris Motor with others. With her at the time she was picked up were William Pyne, Reynolds Rinker, Dick Peterson, Steven Zufelt, Elton Denzley, R. G. Christensen, and Don Kellog. Denzley lives at [Redacted] Unwarranted Invasion of Personal Privacy Christensen lives at about [Redacted] Unwarranted in Crem. Pyne is from Springville---no addresses on the others.
