Victim referred to as being "boy crazy" however unknown if she had had any sex relations with anyone.

Victim reportedly had never used any type of drugs.

On 7-13-69, at 1630 hours, the victim was found in a densely wooded area in a deep gully off of Pescadero Road and Delores in Carmel. The area where body was found is used as a roadside dump. The victim was found nude except for white sandals and a cloth belt. The belt was wrapped around her neck. No indication of sexual molestation. Underwear found near the scene, the crotch of the panties were torn out and missing. Numerous photographs and papers belonging to the victim were found along a road, strewn over a 100 yard area.

The victim disappeared from a friends home on 6-30-69. She had gone out in the early afternoon to mail a letter and was not seen again.

Victims mother stated she would go along with " any young man between 17-25, who was not dirty in appearance and having a persuasive manner about him.

Victim made phone calls every day at about 1400 hours from a pay phone in a gas station. Unknown who calls were being made to or why.

On 7-31-71, the victim was found in a shallow grave near a drainage ditch in Rio Linda. The grave consisted of some sand being scooped out and then replaced over the victim. Victim was not wearing a bra but did have on her blouse and shoes. Her cutoff pants were removed and in the grave with her. Victim was rendered unconscious with a blow to the face, and buried alive. She died as a result of inhaling sand until she suffocated. Missing is the victims backpack, and ring. She was possibly sexually molested.

Victim was a hippy type, hitchhiking from Santa Cruz to Nevada City. She was last seen alive on 7-29-71 at 1400 hours when she was in a liquor store in the Northgate area. On 3-10-73, at 1140 hours the victim was located in mountains near Kyburz, 150 yards north of Hwy-50.
