With reference to your first question, our main fingerprint file contains the fingerprints of arrested persons. As you have been previously advised, no arrest record was located for the victim Cheri Jo Bates.

Five of the six unidentified latent fingerprints reported in this case have been searched through our single fingerprint file, but no identifications were effected. Although the sixth unidentified latent fingerprint is of value for identification purposes, it lacks sufficient area and detail to warrant a search of that file. The fingerprints of military personnel are not contained in our single fingerprint file.

Comparisons of the latent prints reported in this case will be made with the fingerprints of any suspects you name. When
