The above and following information is all correct and was given freely.

On ~~Thursday~~ ^{Friday} morning Feb. 1, 1974, I was awoken by a phone call from Lynda's work, saying she hadn't shown up, two minutes later they called again, ~~was~~ wondering if her bike was gone. Karen then checked for her bike, which was still there, she also checked Lynda's room, the room was very neat and the bed was made, something Lynda rarely does before going to work. I left for school at 8:00 AM and came home at 5:00 PM. Lynda had still not come home. She had plans for a special dinner for her family and boyfriend at our house, at 6:00 PM or so. She was planning on being home all afternoon to clean house and to cook the meal. I later went down to her room to see about clothing missing, this is still on Friday nite & early Sat. morning, I then found her nightie draped across the bottom pole in her closet, finding a smear of blood ~~on it~~ on the shoulder. I think the curtains were slightly opened, ~~but~~ but I don't know if possibly one of the officers had opened them.

I remember Karen saying Friday morning that the side door was unlocked. We usually try to make a habit of locking it, but I don't remember locking it Thurs. nite to see that it was locked. The door is primarily used for taking our bikes in and out of the house. I didn't ride my bike that Thurs. so the side door was not used by me at all. Usually if someone does ride there bike they take it out the side door and then go back in the house through the side door and out the back door which locks itself on shutting it (it has no key).

Police Dogs Used In Hunt for Coed

Dogs of the Seattle Police Department K-9 division combed a large area in the University District yesterday in search of evidence that might lead to the finding of U. of W. coed Lynda Ann Healy, 21, missing since Thursday.

Ban (Puff) Vote Is (Hack!) No

SACRAMENTO — (UPI) — The California Assembly yesterday killed a measure to ban smoking in assembly committee rooms amid warnings it would "wreck the committee process."

With a dozen lawmakers puffing on cigars, pipes and cigarettes, the measure by Assemblyman John V. Briggs, R-Fullerton, was rejected on a 30-32 vote.

A police spokesman said yesterday the case is now being investigated by the Homicide Division. But the spokesman hastened to add that "we have nothing to show a crime has been committed. But we are assuming something could have happened."

Police found very small amounts of blood on sheets and pillow cases of Miss Healy's bed at her 5517-12th Ave. NE home. It has not yet been determined if the blood is that of Miss Healy.

The missing girl, who worked as an announcer of ski conditions for several Seattle-area radio stations, is described as being 5 feet 7 inches tall, 115 pounds, with long hair, blue eyes and a small scar on her nose.

Police say a red pack sack, owned by Miss Healy, is also missing from her home.

19 days is approximately half of 36 days. July 4 would be the next due date on this theory. But July 4 is neither a working weekday nor a schoolday.

All the happenings were on weekdays. (schooldays)

Heidi lived in an area known as rooming area for U.W. students.

Heidi was tied in possibly with a white van truck. (per newspaper)

Do any white van trucks call on universitys in a SALES capacity or SUPPLY capacity?

A van could be parked in an alley and appear to be delivering. A van can hide cargo or?

A van is sometimes used as a "camper" and lived in by the driver.

***What do the universitys and colleges have IN COMMON? They of course have in common that they buy food and certain supplies. Some of these supplies come in vans and they are delivered on WEEKDAYS. Do entertainers or lecuturers visit the same circuit? Some-one applying for work at these schools, someone supplying drugs at these schools. If all these ARE tied in together, I suspect the culprit is ~~HEIDI~~ HEADQUARTERED IN Seattle.

Do child molesters ALSO go after young adults? Is that their "M.O.?"

Do 36 and 19 days tie in with this years full moon and non full moon phases? I don't think they do, otherwise that would be an interesting observation too. Are the nights of dissappearances reasonably moonless?

I have a four year old daughter myself so I have followed the Heidi case in particular.

Wasn't the last girl from near Tacoma, near Fort Lewis? Could know a soldier!

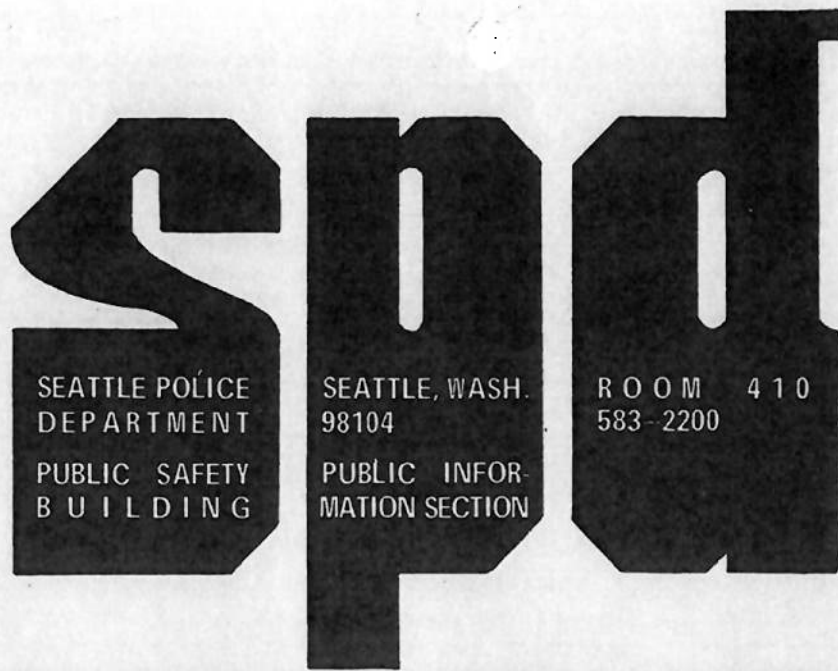
Received a call from Mrs. Healy who stated that she was very happy with the manner in which you two have been conducting the investigation thus far and who wanted to give you the following information: the man who rented the house to the girls was a Mr. Taylor who lives up the street from the house. Prior to the girls being in the house, it was rented to five boys. Mrs. Healy feels that this might be something to look into as one or more of the boys might have had keys to the house. Ginger will be available in the morning and knows where Mr. Taylor lives. Received call on 02-05-74 at 1945 Hours.

Also:

Received a call from a Duane Bennett, 8032 28th Ave. N.E., 522-5448, who is self-employed as a hair-dresser at the House of Edward, 808 E. Roy St., EA-4-3151. Mr. Bennett excitedly advised this detective that he and his wife went out to dinner this evening and during the meal he, being a psychic clairvoyant (a condition brought on by a hole in the head-in Mr. Bennett's own words) experienced a psychic experience. He has not read the papers in several days and claims to have no knowledge of this case but during this experience he was told the name Linda Jean Neely or Healy, the address of 5517 12th Ave. N.E., parents live in Bellevue while the girl lives in a basement apartment in the U-district, blood is involved and, get this, a feeling of sexuality. Immediately after this experience he had another experience in which the names Don Jennings and Senolia (sp) came out. Advised him that Don Jennings was the sheriff of Snohomish County recently killed in Mexico. We then took out the atlas and found that the county in which Jennings was killed was Sinaloa. Bennett, of course, had no knowledge of Jennings or any of the facts surrounding his death. He now feels that the two experiences are not related. Well, to continue on, Bennett stated that in the past when he has held a semi-precious object belonging to the person involved (an object that has not been handled too much by other persons) he has experienced psychic clairvoyance which has been of some value. Bennett stated that he felt the police should have this information so that if other scientific methods fail he might be contacted for whatever assistance that he might be able to offer. Mr. Bennett stated that the police detectives might "pooch pooch" this information but this detective hurriedly advised him that the two day shift detectives handling the investigation were always interested in the latest scientific techniques in criminal investigation even if they did not come from the Halls of Knowledge of the Southern Police Institute. It is not this detective's function to comment upon the facts, only to report them. Good Luck!!!
